

### The Library Catalogue/WebApp

AccessIT is the central website for the THS Library and provides details of the resources we hold, both physical books and eBooks. Students can use this in school by clicking Library from the start menu or from the main school website under the School & Community tab.

- 1. Type a title, author, keyword (e.g. immigration) in the search bar at the top of the page, then hit enter.
- 2. The books and other resources matching this term will now be listed on the initial results page.

If logged in you can reserve books, access ebooks etc but you do not need to be logged in to search the catalogue. To login to AccessIT click on ^ next to Login (top right) and then click on Click here to Login. You will need your school email and password to login.




A collection of ebooks is available to all students and staff at **www.vlebooks.com** To access the site, sign in using **Office 365** which is your school email and password.

### **Dorset Public Libraries**



The public library is richly equipped to support students and staff with reading for pleasure. You can join Dorset Libraries via digital membership which takes a few minutes and you can upgrade to full membership if you wish.

To join, you will need to register online.

Digital membership provides access to online resources only on the LibrariesWest website including e-books, audiobooks, e-magazines, e-newspapers, e-comics and e-reference.

You can convert your digital membership to a full membership to borrow physical books, audio books and DVDs, by visiting your local library with proof of address.

Where can I use my card? You can use your card in any of the 31 <u>libraries in Dorset</u>.

You can also use your membership card in any <u>LibrariesWest</u> libraries in: Dorset, Bath and North East Somerset, Bristol, North Somerset, Poole, Somerset, South Gloucestershire You can borrow, return and reserve items to libraries in these areas. You can also use the library computers.
