EXAM INVIGILATORS REQUIRED

If so, you are invited to our drop-in session with the exams team and some of our existing invigilators for a casual chat.

We are seeking individuals who can promote a calm and supportive atmosphere for our students so that they achieve their best. Experience in working within an educational setting is preferred, however we will also welcome applications from those with no previous experience, but who are good at interpreting lists, following guidance and are prepared to take on responsibility. Training is provided for all invigilators every year.

Work is paid by the hour (down time between exams is not paid) and is currently £9.60 (+12% = £10.75) and is based around school hours; the role is suited to all members of the community. You would need to be available most school days in May and June (we will let you know the actual days you are working several weeks before).

If you are interested, we would love to see you at our drop-in session to chat about the role with likeminded people whilst enjoying a coffee or tea. Applications will be available to take away on the day for those who feel inspired to apply!
